COVID-19 Update:

Welcome back to the second half of the Autumn Term. I am pleased to report that so far, we have been fortunate that no child or adult at school has tested positive for COVID-19. We would like to continue to ensure the safety and well-being of everyone at Downsell Primary School. We are asking that when collecting children, parents do not block the door entrances. Please also ensure that you keep your distance of 2m from other adults and children and that you wear a mask if you are able to. Please be sure to follow the school protocol when entering and leaving the school gates. All the measures we have put in place is to keep everyone safe.

Homework/PE clothing Expectations:

It is the expectation that homework is given out by class teachers every Friday. The homework should then be completed by your child/children and returned to the class teacher on Wednesday morning. Please ensure that all homework is returned on time. If there is a problem with returning your child/childrens homework, please inform the class teacher as soon as possible. We will be sending letters home when homework is not completed so we can work together to support our children.

Reminder: children should come to school wearing their PE clothing on the days they are meant to have PE. Every class has 2 PE sessions per week.

Curriculum Update:

I am delighted with our new curriculum which we have introduced from Year 1 – Year 6. Please take a look at the texts each year group is doing on our newsletter tomorrow. Why not talk with your child about his/her learning at school and see how this is going.
