



Downsell School Nursery Fees & Charges

At Downsell Primary School our Nursery is open Term time only for 38 weeks of the year. We provide 15 and 30hr spaces depending on your needs and entitlements. (Subject to availability)

Under the Government scheme parents/carers are entitled to an annual free early education and childcare entitlement of 30hrs per week over 38 weeks per annum, which equates to 1140hrs per year.

Downsell operates Monday-Friday 8:40am-3:30pm, offering sessions of over 6 hours of childcare per day. Session timetables below.

AM	8:40 - 11:40	15hrs
PM	12:30 - 15:30	15hrs
Full Time	8:40 - 15:30	30hrs (50mins free lunch daily)

The setting operates during term-time only (38 weeks per annum) and therefore offer the annual free early education and childcare entitlement as 30hrs per week over 38 weeks per annum.

The setting offers places to children from 2 years old until the child reaches statutory school age.

Working parents/carers who want to just take up their full free early education and childcare hours (30 hours per week) can do this and are able to take this up over the 5 days of their choice (subject to availability).

Where parents/carers choose to purchase childcare hours which are in addition to/outside of their free early education and childcare hours, these will be charged at the rates below.

Pupils that are attending 30hours will be here during lunch. An application for free school meals will need to made. If your child is not entitled, you will need to provide a packed lunch of pay for a school lunch.

We offer Breakfast and After School Provision (**3&4 year olds only**) for parents/carers that need these services. See below for hours and prices per session.
