FAMILY FUN 5-11 YEAR OLDS

THIS SUMMER WE HAVE A WIDE RANGE OF FREE EXCITING ACTIVITIES ACROSS THE BOROUGH AVAILABLE FOR YOU TO ENJOY WITH YOUR FAMILY. THE SESSIONS WILL PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN TO TRY NEW ACTIVITIES AND LEARN NEW SKILLS, WHILST HAVING FUN AND MAKING NEW FRIENDS.

All sessions are led by Waltham Forest Play Workers, with specialist workshops provided by professionals from a variety of local organisations.

Most activities run for 45 minutes to enable all children to be able to try everything on offer during each session, and allow families to join at any time throughout the session.

Details of the dates and times of these activities are on the following pages so you can plan your time throughout the summer.

Activities that are taking place over the summer include:

Artsmart Workshop

Come and take part in a wildlife inspired block printing sessions. During the session you will learn to learn to draw the outline of bugs, transfer the drawings to foam board and then will be shown how to roll block printing ink on their block and transfer in onto fabric.

Multi Sports – Leyton Orient Football

Leyton Orient coaches will provide a multi-sport programme in which children can play sports including athletics, netball, basketball, uni hockey and football.

Bollyfusion

Bollyfusion is an exciting and innovative dance session for children. It is an exciting combination of movement from Bollywood, classical Indian, hip hop and jazz forms.

Salsa

Salsa is a popular form of social dance with strong influences from Latin America, particularly Cuba and Puerto Rico. The movements of salsa are rhythmical, fun and upbeat and can be done in pairs or individually, which fun for any age group.

Punch and Judy

Come along and enjoy a traditional Punch and Judy show.

Face Painting

Come and have your face painted by a local expert face painter.

Balloon Science

Balloons are fun, right? Well if balloons are fun then that must mean that science is fun!

The Balloon science show is full of spills, thrills explosions and pops!



Recycled Art

Participants will get the chance to use found objects and recycled materials to create pieces of art.

Street Dance

Street Dance is a fun and exciting mix of Hip Hop, Locking, Popping and Waving.

African Drumming

Come along and give African Drumming a try.

Tile Painting

Create and paint your own colourful tile design inspired by William Morris's birds & beasts, flowers and plants. Take home instructions to bake your tile in the oven to fix colours for permanent display.

Fabric Printing William Morris Style

Be inspired by Morris's rich patterns inspired by the Islamic World create your own repeat design to print on a cotton bag using stencils and your own print block to take home and use. Iron it to make your colours last.

Make your own William Morris Inspired Book Plate

Creating a unique stamp to print your initials in surrounded by patterns and designs inspired by William Morris and nature to identify your books and special possessions.

Using Natural Dyes

Looking at William Morris' designs and using natural dyes, such as onion skin, beetroot to tie-dyeing, fabrics: make resist different patterns, using elastic bands, string, or hand stitching and fabric pens Take your samples away, no two designs will ever be alike!

Circus Skills

Ever wondered if you could ride a uni-cycle, walk a tight wire or juggle 5 balls?

Now's your chance; the circus is in town!



Puppet Mayhem

Join E17 Puppet Project as we explore the Icelandic Sagas and William Morris. Create and use your own rod and sock puppets with the help of our experienced puppeteers.

Stomping

Stomping is an Earthy dance style that uses body percussion and vocal sounds to create beats and rhythms without using traditional instrumentation.

Safari Animals Puppet Making

Little Angel Theatre will be running drop-in workshops where participants make their own safari animal puppet from a paper bag! Using their own wacky ideas participants will use a variety of materials to make and decorate their own puppet to take home with them!

African Drumming and Dance

Participants have the opportunity to learn dances that go with the drumming rhythms in addition to learning how to play drum rhythms.

Creative Dance

Creative Dance is a great way to empower the young people through developing their own dance skills, using new found techniques, as well as having the opportunity to express themselves through devising their own choreography.



Lion King Workshop

A member of the West End Show Lion King will teach songs and dances from the show. In addition there will be Lion King themed games and arts and crafts.

Magic Workshop

In the workshops the children will not only get to see some jaw dropping magic but will learn themselves some of the secrets of magic and how to perform for their family and friends.

Come and meet the friendly animals from Waltham Forest Suntrap Centre.
