On Tuesday 17th July we look forward to celebrating with the children who have had fantastic attendance with 100% this academic year.



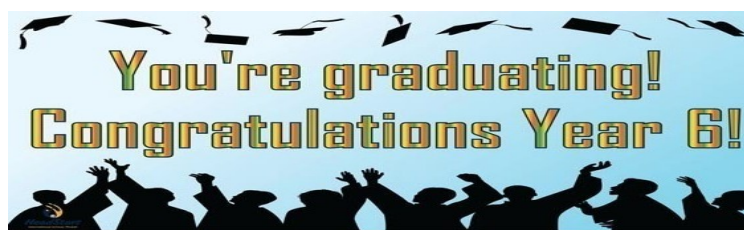
FOODBANK
