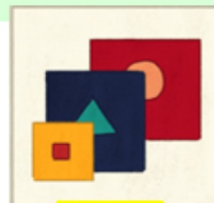

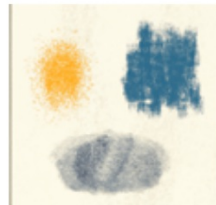

Margaret Godfrey

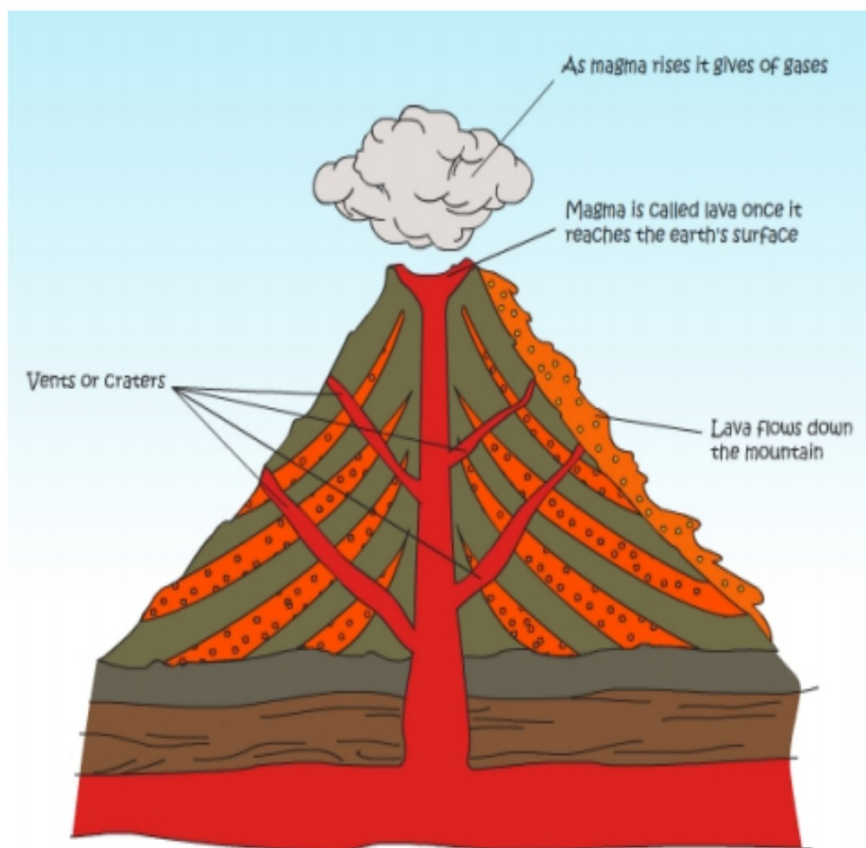


Margaret is a self-educated artist with a background in education and counselling.

Here is a diagram of a cross section of a volcano.



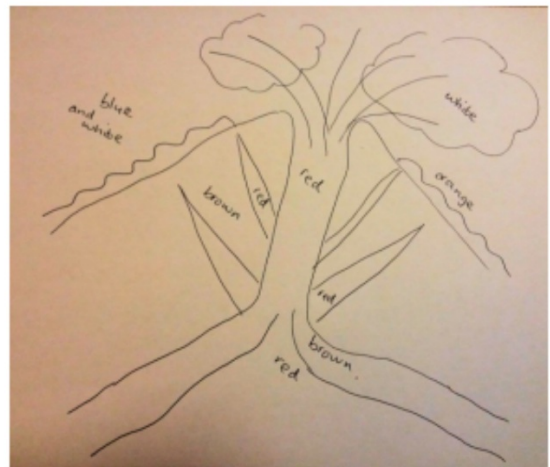


Here is a piece of art by Margaret Godfrey. She is an artist who creates pictures of volcanoes using layers of tissue and glue.

Artists like Margaret Godfrey plan their work out before they start.

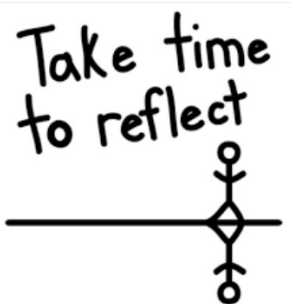
Draw your volcano on your piece of paper.

Step 1

Spread PVA glue on the tile/card. Start by making the background by layering up different 'sky' colours



Step 2

Construct your volcano shape, remembering to pay close attention to your initial sketch.



Step 3

Build up the vents/craters and fill with lava, Do all this with orange and red tissue paper.



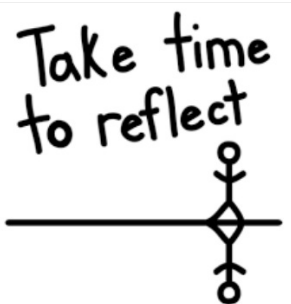
Step 4
