

To separate or link two independent clauses.




In order to use semi-colons, you need to have two independent clauses that link together.

The frail cub was extremely cold; He cuddled his mum to get warm.

Grey wolves are known for their grey skin. The mountains are large in the Arctic.

TTYP: Can we use a semi-colon to join these two sentences? Explain why/why not.

We cannot use a semi-colon because these two independent clauses are not linked together.





For example: White wolves can camouflage with their environment.



Grey wolves have legendary spine-tingling howls.



Wolves will fight for leadership of the pack.



Most wolves live in packs of around six to ten animals.
