Covid Updates

As you will be aware, there have been updates regarding Covid in the news recently. Although there is no changed guidance for primary schools, our priority is to keep our families and staff safe, especially as we approach the holidays.

As a school, we will continue to keep in place our current measures:

- Phase bubbles for children.
- Social distancing for seating plans.
- Limiting the amount of visitors to the school / school office.
- Frequent handwashing for all.

In addition to this, we have now taken the following actions, which started from this week:

- Staff wearing masks in communal areas.
- Ensuring that parents drop off at the entrance in the morning and staff escort children to classes.
- Appointment only system for the school office.
- Postponing of school sports trips where the children would mix with other schools.

We ask that parents / carers support us by ensuring they follow the current Covid guidance to keep their families and the school community safe.
