Behaviour & Rewards

<u>Home Reading</u>



Pupils are expected to read regularly at home for a minimum of 15 minutes each day. They should choose a book that matches their reading ability. When your child receives a reading, record please remind your child to bring their reading record into school daily - as the teachers will be monitoring their progress.



<u>Cultural Capital</u>

The curriculum is designed to instill high aspirations in all our children and to encourage them to become resilient life-long learners. This half term we will be looking at a contrasting locality and will be comparing similarities and differences between an urban and a rural environment.

<u>Homework</u>

Children will be given homework on Friday. It is an ideal opportunity for parents to work with their child at home. It would be beneficial if you encourage your child to complete and hand in their homework on a regular basis.

Healthy Schools

We would like to remind parents that we are a healthy school and that your child is encouraged to eat healthily at lunchtime. If your child is bringing a packed lunch, please ensure that it reflects a healthy meal. Please could parents ensure that the school office is aware of any serious allergies that your child may have.
