

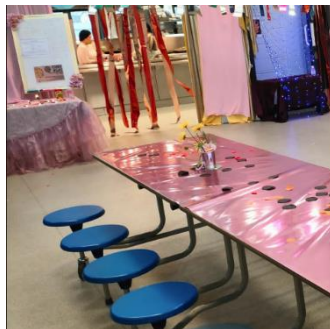
Last Week
