School Streets

As you might be aware, from the leaflets that were given to children, the Local Authority will be introducing a 'School Street' around Downsell Primary School from Monday 10th October 2022.

Which roads will be affected and when?

The roads where vehicles will be restricted, at the start and end of the school day are:

- Brierley Road
- Downsell Road (between Ellingham Road and Modal Filter)
- Hall Road spur (from junction with Hall Road)

The restrictions will be enforced, Monday to Friday, term time only (not including bank holidays) between 8:15am - 9:15am and 2:45pm - 3:45pm.

Road signs will be displayed at all entry and exit points to the pedestrian and cycle zone advising of the restrictions. The restrictions will be supported by legal Traffic Management Orders and any vehicles that are not exempt will be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN). The cost of the PCN will be £130, which will be reduced to £65 if paid within 14 days.

A reminder that our school attendance monitoring procedures are in place for this academic year. We will be meeting weekly with our school's attendance officer and monitoring the attendance of all children.

We have now been back at school for 4 full weeks and if your child has had 3 days off in this period then their attendance will have dropped to 85% already. While there may be valid reasons for their absences, it is important that as parents / carers you are aware of the impact of any days off school on your child's overall attendance figure. If you have any questions about attendance or need support to improve your child's attendance please ask at the school office.

Punctuality

We have done so well with punctuality this year – well done to all the families who are trying hard every day to ensure that their child / children are in school on time. School doors are open for children to come to class from 8.45am and the register is taken at 8.55am.

Did you know?

5 minutes late every day = 3 days of learning lost each academic year 10 minutes late every day = 6.5 days of learning lost each academic year 15 minutes late every day = 10 days of learning lost each academic year 20 minutes late every day = 13 days of learning lost each academic year 30 minutes late every day = 30 days of learning lost each academic year
