We encourage this daily in school through the use of assemblies, worry boxes and our 'Give me 5!' hand templates, where children wrote the names of 5 people they could speak to if they are worried.

Following on from watching the NSPCC assembly, the children will receive a Childline card, which is another way for them to discuss any worries they may have.
